ARE YOU TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THIS TRAINING?

Training Opportunities Available. Each year, the West Virginia Propane Gas Association applies for a PERC grant to supply CETP training to all in the industry around the state. This year, in addition to providing Basic Principles & Practices classes (which are required before any other CETP training), classes in Propane Delivery Operations/Bobtail Delivery are offered. After last month's Bobtail Rodeo, this kind of driver training is a perfect compliment.

Two Locations from Which to Choose. These classes are being held at the Tamarack Conference Center, Beckley, WV in July and Days Inn Suites, Bridgeport, WV in August. The registration fees include books, tests, AM & PM breaks and lunch.

Important Note: While most classes start at 8 am each day, the Propane Delivery Operations/Bobtail Delivery classes start at 7 am so that all the material can be covered.

Special Class Offered. New for this year is the *NFPA Refresher Training* which is required of everyone every 3 years! It is one day of instruction with test. The topics covered include HazMat Employee Training and Procedures Required for Propane Delivery Drivers. This class meets NFPA Requirements that has been in place since 2001!

Deadlines Coming Up. The deadline for the Beckley class is July 6, 2012; for Bridgeport it is August 3rd. However, if classes sell out, you don't want to be one left out. After these dates, please call the Association Office at 888-441-5454 or 703-530-9772 to make sure that there is still space.

PERC Launches Marketer Technology & Sales Training Program

The Propane Education & Research Council launched its Marketer Technology and Sales Training (MTST) program, free one-day classes on propane-fueled products

along with customized sales tips.



The MTST will emphasize new

products and beefed up sales training to help marketers identify and break into new markets as well as maximize existing ones.

Classes will focus on tankless water heaters, commercial lawn mowers, irrigation engines, on-road vehicles and fleets, generators, and assorted residential equipment.

"The sessions will address not only the 'what' but the 'how' to succeed in these markets that offer promising gallon growth potential," Pat Hyland, PERC director of industry programs, said. "The day-long sessions deliver hands-on exposure to new products, introduce marketers to local equipment dealers, and let marketers take their new sales skills for a test drive."
